St Albans School is committed to protecting your privacy and security. This Notice is intended to provide information about how the Sports Centre will use (or process) the data of its members. Some members may also be staff, current pupils or alumni of St Albans School, or parents of current pupils or alumni, in which case other Privacy Notices will also apply; these are available on the School website. As part of its operations, the School collects and processes data and thus is a data controller for the purposes of legislation relevant to the Data Protection Act 2018, UK General Data Protection Regulation and other relevant Data Protection Legislation.

The School will **never** sell your data. We will **never** share your data with anyone unless required to by law, or if doing so is under the lawful basis of vital interests (e.g. in the event of a medical emergency).

This information is provided in accordance with your rights under Data Protection Law to understand how we use your data. Members of St Albans School Sports Centre are encouraged to read this Privacy Notice and understand the School's obligations to its community.

YOUR RIGHTS

Under data protection legislation, you have the right to:

- Be informed about the collection and use of your personal data
- Rectify incorrect or incomplete personal information we hold on you
- Erasure, or be forgotten, by asking us to remove your personal data
- Make a Subject Access Request (SAR) for the personal data we hold on you
- Withdraw your consent, or change or restrict your processing and communication preferences at any time by using the contact details above

- Object to certain purposes and bases for processing your personal data

Note that we may not always be able to comply with your request (e.g. if we are legally required to store the data, we would not be able to comply with a request for erasure), but we will always reply to your request. WHY AND HOW WE PROCESS DATA

The Sports Centre processes data on its members for the following purposes:

- Membership administration (including processing membership payment) and informing you of Member timetables. The lawful basis for this processing is it is necessary for the performance of a contract.
- To advise members of upcoming events, promotions and classes. The lawful basis for this processing is legitimate interest.
- To provide prompt and appropriate medical care. The lawful basis for this processing is vital interests and special category processing explicit consent.
- To maintain records as required by law. The lawful basis for this processing is legal obligation including CCTV and ANPR for security purposes in accordance with the School's CCTV Policy.

WHAT INFORMATION WE PROCESS

We process the following information on Sports Centre members:

- Contact information (name, address, telephone number, e-mail address);
- An identifying photograph of you (which is printed on your membership card);
- Records of postal, telephone or email communications sent to and received from you;
- Records of your membership payments;
- Medical information (as supplied in the pre-exercise questionnaire and collected during membership, e.g. accident forms);
- CCTV images and recordings from public areas of the School site, including ANPR at School entrances. For further information on this, please see the CCTV Policy available on the School's website.

DATA RETENTION

Personal data on Sports Centre members is held for the duration of the membership and up to one year thereafter. Data may be held for longer where legally required (e.g. accountancy records and accident report forms) or in line with specific retention policies, e.g. accident forms.
